The first ever Gang Show was written for the Boy Scouts of England, by Ralph Reader, then a member of the Holborn Rovers who was at that time setting out on what was to be, a distinguished career as an actor, choreographer, and later a theatrical producer of note in both London and New York.

Our own show, Auckland Central Gang Show first opened in 1969 as the Waitemata District Gang Show, changing it's name to Auckland Central Gang Show in 1972.

Originally the show performed material written by Ralph Reader but as the years passed we began to write and perform our own material which today makes up a large percentage of the material you will see presented on stage.

So, with a cast of around ninety talented guys and gals, a support team of over a hundred including a live orchestra why not make it a date, come and see the extravaganza that is—
